**Learning Outcomes:**

**On successful completion of this assessment package a student will have demonstrated competence in the following areas:**

[LO3] select and apply appropriate animation techniques to produce an animated asset;

**Flash Animated Interface**

Produce a Flash animated introduction and interface for a feature film or computer game website.

This assignment allows you to develop an understanding of the animation / interactive possibilities of Adobe Flash. Your completed assignment should explore the use of key frames, motion “tweening”, shape “tweening”, scenes, instance properties, buttons, pre-loaders, ActionScripting and should also include sound.

Flash is a vector based multimedia package that can produce small files that are ideal for use on the Internet. Video / photographic / audio can also be used but they have an impact on the overall size of the file, the smoothness and speed of the animation. Your work will probably require pre-loader sequences to deal with this issue.

The introduction animation should last between 10-20seconds and end on an animated interface that links to other established web pages. HTML should be used to place the final work in a web browser. The work should be fully visible on a 1024 x 768 monitor.

The development of this assessment should be detailed in your blog.

## **Submission Guidelines**

You should submit the final work (FLA, SWF. & HTML files) on a labelled CD / DVD (individual name, enrolment number, degree course, unit title & code, blog url).

This unit is graded using a criterion reference grid. You should be clear in your understanding of the grading principles; if you are not, please seek the advice of the unit co-ordinator.
